Chocolate

Chocolate is made from the seeds of the cacao tree. The cocoa beans are first fermented, or broken down in a special process to become juicy. During fermentation, the chocolate aroma, or smell, appears. Then, the beans are spread out to dry. After the beans are roasted, the chocolate makers crush the beans to make cocoa butter, and liquid comes out of them. Finally, ingredients such as sugar and milk are added before it is heated and mixed. The ingredients make different flavors of chocolate.


