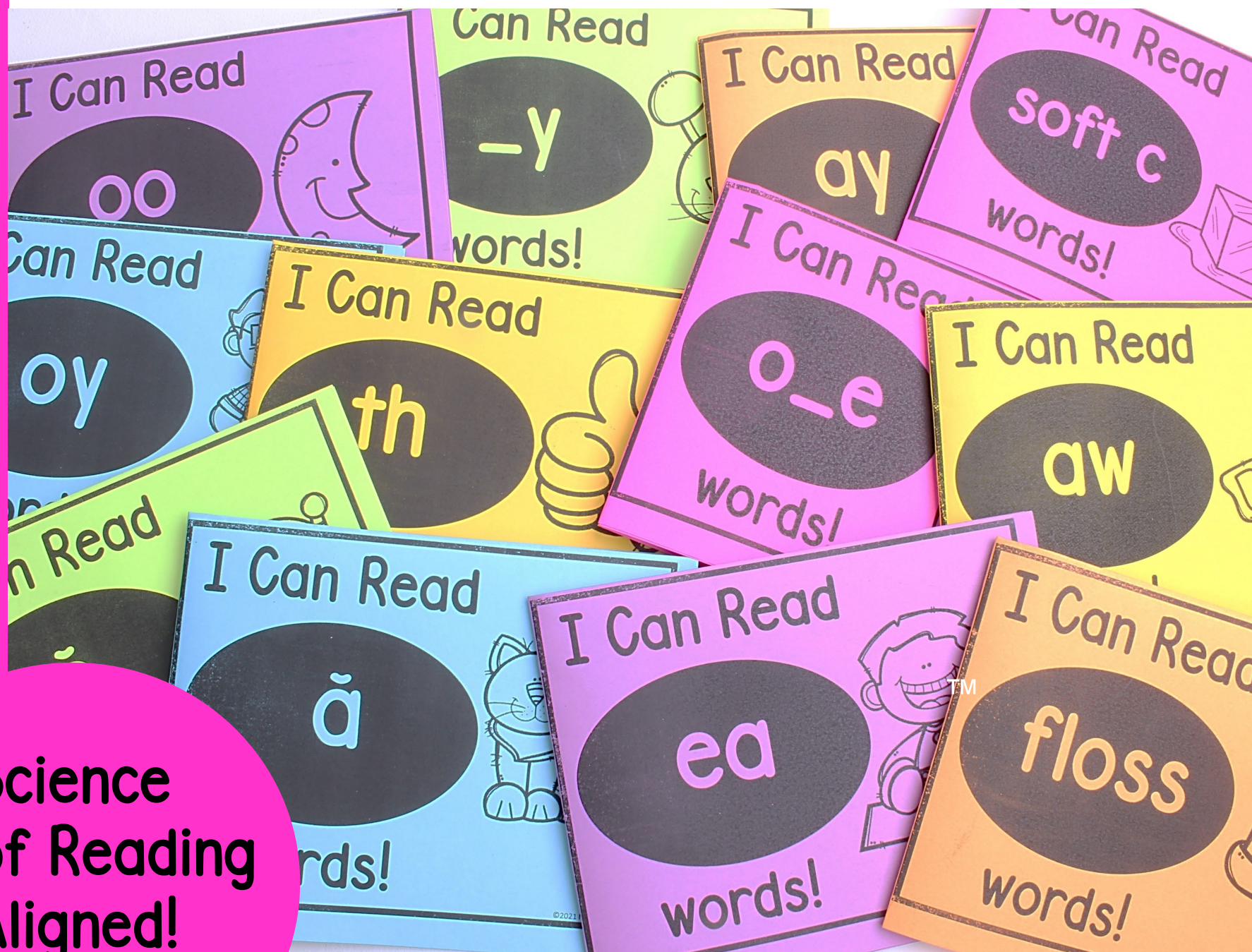


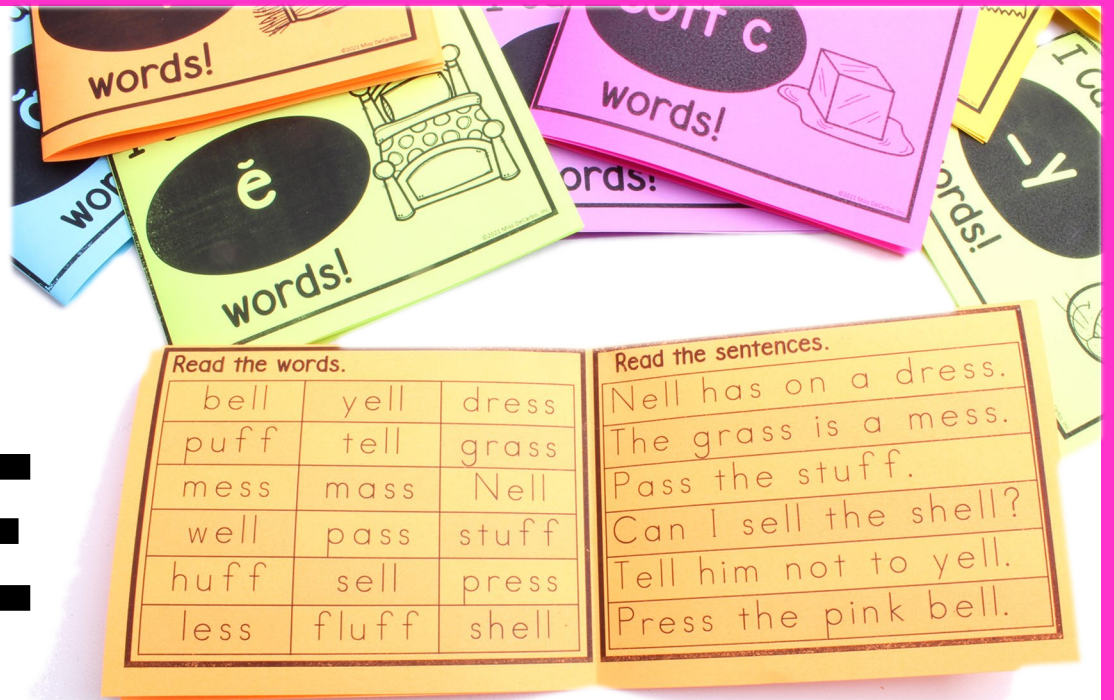

ABOUT THIS RESOURCE



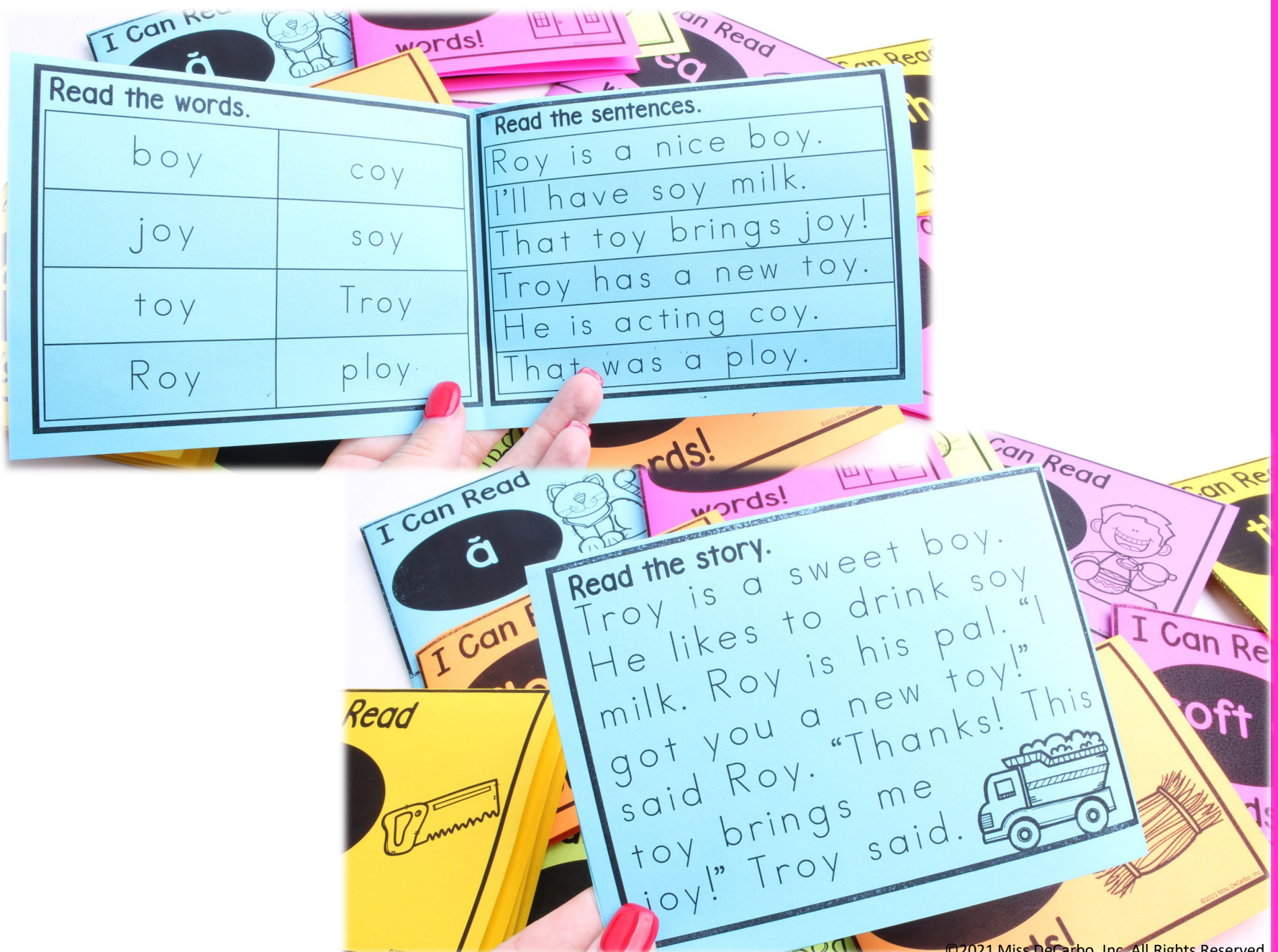

They will also take their mini books home to practice with their families. Each short focused book is the perfect way for families to see the phonics pattern we are working on and practice reading words that focus on that pattern with their children.

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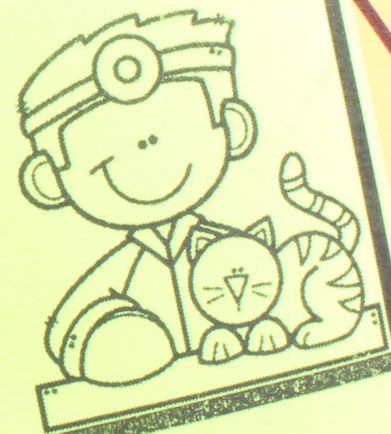
