

LEVEL ONE DISCUSSION CARDS

Level One Discussion Cards require students to give TWO examples or ideas in their responses during the "Think, Talk, Teach" routine. They MUST use the conjunction "and."

LEVEL TWO DISCUSSION CARDS

In Level Two, students will practice not only giving a response but explaining the WHY to their partner, group, or the class. They MUST use the "because" conjunction that is posted on the card when they teach their

Students must use the conjunction "because" to explain why in order to elaborate their thinking.

LEVEL THREE DISCUSSION CARDS

In this final level, students will practice linking at least three ideas and/or examples within their response. This is great practice as your students internalize the concept of "commas in a series." Coming up with three ideas or examples also requires a lot of thinking for some kids! ©

What are three things you are really good āt?≠



For example:

I am really good at playing soccer and coloring

Students must use the conjunction "and" to list at least three examples and/or ideas in their response. The comma on the card will signal to students that this is an extended response with at least three ideas and/or examples!
